Access ramps temporarily close at Anthony Henday Drive and Yellowhead Trail in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that two access ramps will be closed at the interchange of Anthony Henday Drive and Yellowhead Trail, starting at 7 p.m. May 8 and continuing until 6 a.m. May 11.

Motorists travelling eastbound on Yellowhead Trail and wanting to access Anthony Henday Drive/Ray Gibbon Drive are asked to use the next interchange at 184 Street to turn around and approach the interchange from the westbound direction.

Motorists travelling southbound on Ray Gibbon Drive/Anthony Henday Drive wanting to access Yellowhead Trail eastbound are asked to travel westbound on Yellowhead Trail and use the 215 Street interchange to turn around and access Yellowhead Trail eastbound.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and message boards. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
