Bridge work closes lanes on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary

Closures are not in effect for Victoria Day long weekend

Calgary... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures on 16 Avenue NE in Calgary.

The closures begin May 15 and affect both eastbound and westbound 16 Avenue NE between 68 Street NE and 100 Street NE. The lane closures accommodate overhead bridge work, concrete pouring, and median work. At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

The closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. until June 1, weather permitting. The closures will not be in effect during the May 16-18 Victoria Day long weekend and will resume on May 19.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
