Construction disrupts nighttime traffic on Highways 21 and 16 near Sherwood Park

Sherwood Park... Motorists can expect nighttime disruptions at the interchange of Highways 21 and 16 near Sherwood Park to accommodate the removal of overhead signs.

Construction work is scheduled for May 27 and if required will continue on May 28 between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m.

The eastbound lanes and the westbound lanes of Highway 16 will be closed separately for approximately 30 minutes each while the overhead signs are removed. The northbound and southbound lanes of Highway 21 will be closed together twice for approximately 30 minutes each.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
