Paying work partially closes Barlow, Peigan Trails in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect delays and partial closures on Barlow Trail and Peigan Trail near their intersection with Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

On May 30, partial closures will occur on the southbound Deerfoot Trail exit ramp to Barlow Trail, northbound Barlow Trail, eastbound Peigan Trail, and the entrance ramp from Peigan Trail to southbound Deerfoot Trail.

On May 31, partial closures will occur on the northbound Deerfoot Trail exit ramp to Barlow Trail, westbound and eastbound Peigan Trail, and the northbound exit ramp to Deerfoot Trail from Barlow Trail.

Closures start at 5 a.m. on both days and are in effect for the full day. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.

The work is part of a larger project to upgrade the Barlow Trail/Peigan Trail intersection and to modify the on-ramp to southbound Deerfoot Trail from Peigan Trail. Visit www.transportation.alberta.ca/bargp.htm for more information on the project.
