Nighttime lane closures extended on Yellowhead Trail in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that the nighttime lane reduction and detour of the westbound lanes of Yellowhead Trail near Anthony Henday Drive has been extended until June 12 and will include weekend work. Traffic will be detoured using the on and off ramps of the interchange at Anthony Henday Drive and Yellowhead Trail daily from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for bridge girder construction.

The Edmonton Police Service will continue to assist with directing traffic. Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, flag people, and police officers. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
