Fort Saskatchewan... Testing on the North Saskatchewan River Bridge will reduce the lane width on Highway 15 in Fort Saskatchewan to 4.5 metres starting June 16 at 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on June 17, weather permitting.

The work will include testing of the bridge deck to determine the timelines for future rehabilitation and repair work. Wide loads are requested to use alternate routes.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
