Construction closes lanes on QE2 near Innisfail

Innisfail... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures and delays on the Queen Elizabeth II Highway near Innisfail.

Milling and paving work starts June 22 and will last for approximately two weeks, weather permitting. Speed will be reduced to 80 km/h through the construction zone and periodic lane closures may be in effect. The work affects both the northbound and southbound lanes.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
