Construction disrupts traffic on Highway 2 in High Prairie

High Prairie... Repaving work on Highway 2 within the Town of High Prairie and intersection improvements at Highway 2 and Range Road 172 are underway. Motorists can expect periodic lane closures and delays. Construction work is scheduled to be completed by July 31, weather permitting.

Construction work will affect both the eastbound and the westbound lanes between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. daily. The speed limit has been reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone and periodic lane closures may be effect.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
