Bridge repairs disrupt traffic on Highway 43 east of Mayerthorpe

Mayerthorpe... Motorists can expect traffic disruptions at the Paddle River Bridge on Highway 43 east of Mayerthorpe near the Rochfort Bridge for deck surface repairs. Construction work will begin June 25 and is scheduled to be completed by June 26, weather permitting.

The eastbound lanes of Highway 43 will be reduced to one lane and the lane width will be restricted to 4 metres.
