Sign work closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect periodic lane closures on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The closures begin June 30 and affect both northbound and southbound Deerfoot Trail between Country Hills Boulevard and the Highway 566 interchange near Balzac. Between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. daily, the inside southbound lane and the outside northbound lane will periodically close. At least two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times.

The lane closures accommodate drilling and concrete pouring for new overhead signs near the new Stoney Trail-Deerfoot Trail interchange. The work will be completed by July 4, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
