Construction disrupts traffic on Highway 63 north of Fort McMurray

Fort McMurray... Motorists can expect traffic disruptions on the Poplar Creek Bridge approximately 20 kilometres north of Ft. McMurray for road surface repairs. The southbound lanes of Highway 63 will be reduced to one lane and will have a 4.0 metre lane width restriction. Work is scheduled to begin July 15 and will be completed by July 16, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
