Construction disrupts traffic on Highway 18 west of Barrhead

Barrhead... Motorists can expect traffic disruptions on Highway 18 approximately 20 kilometres west of Barrhead for a bridge replacement. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and will have a 4.5 metre lane width restriction. Work is scheduled to begin July 15 and will be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 30 km/h. Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
