Bridge repairs disrupt traffic on Highway 22 near Drayton Valley

Drayton Valley... Motorists can expect lane reductions on Highway 22 at the North Saskatchewan River Bridge near Drayton Valley for bridge repairs. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and will have a 3.7 metre lane width restriction. Work is scheduled to begin July 20 and will be completed by July 24, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
