## Chip seal coating disrupts traffic on Highway 2A near Leduc

Leduc... Motorists can expect delays as traffic is moved by pilot vehicle on Highway 2A between Leduc and Millet.

Chip seal construction starts July 22 and affects Highway 2A from south of Millet to the Leduc south city limits. Pilot vehicles will guide traffic through the construction zone and speed will be reduced to 50 km/h through the zone. Work will be completed by July 26, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
