Four lanes open to traffic on Highway 4 near Milk River

Milk River... Motorists are advised that all four lanes of the new Highway 4 bypass at Milk River are now open to traffic.

The highway's south access to the Town of Milk River is also now open to traffic. The speed limit will remain at 80 km/h through the area as signage, line painting, and other work will continue on or near the highway.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.

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
