## Sign work closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

*Calgary...* Motorists can expect periodic lane and shoulder closures on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The closures begin Aug. 4 and affect both northbound and southbound Deerfoot Trail between Country Hills Boulevard and the Highway 566 interchange near Balzac. Between 9 a.m. and 5:30 daily, lanes and/or shoulders periodically may be closed. At least two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times.

The lane closures accommodate sign structure installation. The work will be completed by Aug. 7, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
