Bridge repairs disrupt traffic on Highway 40 north of Hinton

Hinton... Motorists are advised that lane width reductions and delays are anticipated during bridge repairs on the Pinto Creek culvert on Highway 40, approximately 50 kilometres north of Hinton.

Work will begin Aug. 11 and is scheduled to be completed by Aug. 16, weather permitting.

There will be a 3.2 metre lane restriction and 20 minute delays are anticipated from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. Wide loads are asked to use alternate routes.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
