Interchange work closes lanes on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect delays and lane closures on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The closures affect both directions of Deerfoot Trail in and around the Stoney Trail interchange site. At least two lanes in each direction will remain open at all times until Sept. 28. After this date, there will be periodic lane closures during off-peak hours until the end of October, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
