Guardrail work closes a lane on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary

Calgary... Motorists can expect a lane closure on Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The closure begins at 6 a.m. on September 30 and affects the right lane of northbound Deerfoot Trail between Country Hills Boulevard and the Stoney Trail interchange site.
