## \*REVISED\* Bridge repairs detour traffic on Calgary's Douglasdale Boulevard

Calgary... Motorists can expect detours on the Douglasdale Boulevard bridge over Deerfoot Trail in Calgary.

The detours accommodate repairs to the interchange bridge that carries Douglasdale Boulevard over Deerfoot Trail. The eastbound lane of Douglasdale Boulevard will close to traffic at 9 p.m. on Oct. 5 and re-open at 6 a.m. on Oct. 6, weather permitting. During the closure, traffic will be detoured to an alternate route near Barlow Trail.

\*Starting at 9 p.m. on Oct. 6, the westbound lane of Douglasdale Boulevard will close to traffic and re-open at 6 a.m. on Oct. 7, weather permitting. During the closure, traffic will be detoured to an alternate route near Southland Drive.\*

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
