Lanes close on Queen Elizabeth II Highway north of Calgary

Balzac... Motorists can expect nighttime lane closures and speed reductions on the Queen Elizabeth II Highway between Calgary and Balzac.

The closures affect the highway's northbound lanes between the north Calgary city limits and the Highway 566 interchange near Balzac. Northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane and the speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h from 10 p.m. on Jan. 13 to 6 a.m. on Jan. 14, weather permitting. There will be one 15-minute period during these times when all northbound lanes will be closed.

The lane closures and speed reduction accommodate overhead sign installation.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
