Nighttime lane reductions disrupt traffic on Yellowhead Trail near Anthony Henday Drive in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that both eastbound and westbound Yellowhead Trail will be subject to periodic and alternating lane reductions between 184 Street and 215 Street for steel girder installations, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting March 15 and continuing until March 21.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
