****Revised** Queen Elizabeth II Highway temporarily closes between *Carstairs* and Airdrie**

Airdrie... Motorists are advised that the southbound lanes of Queen Elizabeth II Highway between Airdrie and *Carstairs* are closed until further notice.

On the advice of the RCMP, Alberta Transportation has closed the highway to allow emergency responders to clear numerous collisions that have occurred as a result of extremely poor visibility and blowing snow. The temporary closure also gives highway maintenance personnel an opportunity to clear packed snow from the travel lanes.

A further advisory will be issued when the highway re-opens.
