Queen Elizabeth II Highway re-opens between Carstairs and Airdrie

Traffic moving very slowly, alternate routes recommended

Airdrie... Motorists are advised that the southbound lanes of Queen Elizabeth II Highway have re-opened between Carstairs and Airdrie.

Motorists can expect major delays for the next several hours as traffic is moving very slowly through this area. Emergency and highway maintenance personnel are still removing vehicles from earlier collisions and removing packed snow from the driving lanes.

Motorists are advised to use where possible alternate routes for a few more hours until the backlog of traffic is cleared out.
