Construction disrupts traffic on Highway 63 in Fort McMurray

Fort McMurray... Motorists can expect traffic disruptions on Highway 63 in Fort McMurray from south of Highway 69 to Beacon Hill Drive for durable line marking repairs. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and the speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting May 13 and finishing May 17, weather permitting

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
