Paving disrupts traffic on Highway 33 near Swan Hills

Swan Hills... Motorists are advised that paving work will disrupt traffic on Highway 33 from the intersection of Highway 32 to approximately 28 kilometres north of Swan Hills. Traffic will be reduced periodically to one alternating lane during daylight hours. Construction begins today on the \$11.6-million project and is scheduled to be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting. The project includes Highway 33 paving and the construction of two new safety rest areas north of Swan Hills.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
