Extended lane reduction disrupts traffic on 97 Street in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that lane reductions on 97 Street (Highway 28) in Edmonton will disrupt traffic between 176 Avenue and 195 Avenue (Township Road 542) for ongoing construction of Anthony Henday Drive. Traffic will be reduced periodically to one lane in each direction between May 13 and May 19, with an extended lane reduction beginning May 20 until Oct. 31, weather permitting. Motorists can detour using 82 Street or 127 Street.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
