Paving and road improvements disrupt traffic on Highways 36 and 55 near Lac La Biche

Lac La Biche... Motorists are advised that paving will disrupt traffic on Highway 36 from north of Highway 55 to Highway 881 and on Highway 55 from east of Highway 858 to west of Highway 881. Traffic will be reduced periodically to one alternating lane during daylight hours.

Construction work will also include intersection improvements on Highway 36 at Christie Creek Road and Front Street and on Highway 55 at Highway 663 and the Old Mission Road. In addition, a southbound passing lane will be added to Highway 36 approximately 14 kilometres south of Lac La Biche.

Construction begins June 5 on the \$10-million project and is scheduled to be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
