Cleanup operations close Highway 2A near Red Deer

Red Deer... Motorists are advised that Highway 2A south of Red Deer will be closed for one day to complete cleanup operations related to a June 8 train derailment.

The closure begins at 6 a.m. on June 18 and affects the highway between Mackenzie Road and Lantern Street south of Red Deer. The highway is expected to reopen by 6 p.m. the same day.

Motorists are asked to use alternate routes during the closure.
