Paving closes lanes on Highway 867 near St. Lina

St. Lina... Motorists can expect lane closures and speed reductions on Highway 867 near St. Lina.

Paving begins June 21 and affects 13 km of the highway between St. Lina and the St. Paul County boundary with Lac La Biche County. Traffic will be reduced to one lane while the speed limit will be reduced through 50 km/h through the construction zone.

The work will be completed by July 31, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
