Rail crossing repairs detour Highway 630 traffic near North Cooking Lake

North Cooking Lake... Motorists can expect detours on Highway 630 near North Cooking Lake to accommodate rail crossing repairs.

Highway 630's rail crossing near Range Road 203 will be closed to accommodate the repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto adjacent local roads and the detour route will be marked with signs.

The closure begins at 7 a.m. on June 29 and will be in effect until 5 p.m. on June 30, weather permitting.

Motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes during the repair work.

The repairs were originally to take place June 22-23, but were postponed to accommodate re-routing of trains from flooded rail lines in southern Alberta.

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
