Paving reduces Dunvegan Bridge to one lane

Dunvegan... Motorists can expect delays on the Dunvegan Bridge south of Fairview as the bridge will be reduced to one lane to accommodate paving.

The bridge carries Highway 2 over the Peace River at Dunvegan. Paving begins June 28 and traffic will be reduced to alternating one-lane with a reduced speed limit of 30 km/h through the construction zone. The work will be completed by June 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
