Bridge work reduces lanes on Highway 633 near Villeneuve

Villeneuve... Motorists can expect lane reductions and delays on Highway 633 east of Villeneuve.

Rehabilitation begins July 15 on the bridge carrying Highway 633 over the Sturgeon River east of Villeneuve. Traffic will be reduced to one lane with a 4.5 m width at all times. The \$348,000 project includes a deck overlay and joint replacement. Work will be completed by Oct. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
