Nighttime bridge testing disrupts traffic on Highway 15 near Fort Saskatchewan

Fort Saskatchewan... Motorists can expect traffic disruptions on Highway 15 for bridge deck testing over the North Saskatchewan River on July 14 from 8 p.m. to 1 a.m.

Traffic will be reduced to one alternating lane with a lane width restriction of 4.5 metres. Wide loads are asked to use alternate routes.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
