Bridge work disrupts traffic on Highway 754 northeast of Slave Lake

Slave Lake... Motorists can expect speed reductions on Highway 754 over Sandy Creek, northeast of Slave Lake, for a bridge culvert replacement. The speed limit within the construction zone will be reduced to 40 km/h. Construction work will begin July 16 and is expected to be completed by Aug. 18, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
