Collision reduces lanes on Highway 2 near High River

High River... Motorists are advised that southbound Highway 2 near High River will be reduced to one lane until further notice.

At approximately 6 a.m. on Sept. 16, a collision occurred involving a tractor-trailer unit on southbound Highway 2 approximately five kms south of the Highway 23 interchange near High River. Southbound Highway 2 will be reduced to single-lane traffic until the collision is cleaned up. The speed limit will be reduced to 80 km/h in the cleanup zone. Northbound Highway 2 is not affected.

A further advisory will be issued when the highway fully reopens. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes until then.
