Intersection improvements in Cochrane may disrupt traffic

Cochrane... Motorists are advised to expect periodic traffic disruptions in Cochrane to accommodate improvements to the Highways 1A and 22 intersection.

Construction begins Sept. 28 and includes widening the intersection's radius to effectively create new lanes for westbound Highway 1A and northbound Highway 22. The project also includes relocation of overhead lighting and signal light standards and repainting pavement markings. The work will be completed by Nov. 15, weather permitting.

Motorists may experience periodic lane closures, detours, and speed reductions during the project.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
