## **Pavement repairs disrupt traffic on Highway 28 west of Bonnyville**

*Ashmont...* Motorists can expect speed reductions and lane width restrictions on Highway 28 west of Bonnyville, located approximately seven kilometres east of Ashmont. Construction includes the installation of frost insulation and 100 metres of repaving.

Traffic will be reduced to a single alternating lane with a lane width restriction of four metres. The speed limit will be reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone. Construction work will begin Oct. 4 and is expected to be completed by Oct. 8, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
