Lanes temporarily closed on Highway 16 near Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that traffic will temporarily be reduced to one lane on westbound Highway 16 east of Edmonton.

At approximately 5 p.m. on Oct. 13, a gravel truck struck the CN rail bridge over Highway 16, approximately 500 metres west of the junction with Highway 21. CN is repairing the bridge and the right-hand lane of westbound Highway 16 is closed to accommodate the repairs. The highway is expected to fully reopen by the early evening hours of Oct. 14. Eastbound traffic is not affected.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people.
