Rail crossing repairs temporarily close Highway 20 near Sylvan Lake

Sylvan Lake... Motorists are advised that the rail crossing on Highway 20 near Sylvan Lake will be temporarily closed for two days.

The closure begins Oct. 26 at 6 a.m. and will last until 6 p.m. on Oct. 27, weather permitting. The rail crossing is located on Highway 20 north of Highway 11A near Sylvan Lake. The closure is required to repair the crossing.
