Utility work closes 127th Street in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that 127th Street in Edmonton will be temporarily closed to accommodate underground utility work as part of the Anthony Henday Drive NW ring road project.

The closure begins Oct. 29 at 7 p.m. and affects 127th Street between 167th Avenue and 195th Avenue (Township Road 542). The road will reopen Nov. 1 by 6 a.m., weather permitting.

Motorists are advised to use 142nd Street and 195th Avenue as detour routes. Signs will be in place to direct motorists to those detours.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
