## **Queen Elizabeth II Highway near Lacombe temporarily closes**

*Lacombe...* Motorists are advised that there will be two brief closures of the Queen Elizabeth II Highway near Lacombe to accommodate overhead sign installation.

The closures will take place near the Queen Elizabeth II Highway and Highway 12 interchange west of Lacombe. Starting at 10 p.m. on Nov. 3, northbound Queen Elizabeth II Highway will be closed for approximately 15 minutes.

Starting at 1 a.m. on Nov. 4, southbound Queen Elizabeth II Highway will be closed for approximately 15 minutes.

Overhead sign installation on Highway 12 near the interchange will take place at approximately 4 p.m. on Nov. 3. Both directions of Highway 12 will remain open, but lanes and speed limits will be reduced during the installation.

Motorists are advised to use Highway 2A as an alternate route if travelling on Queen Elizabeth II Highway during the above closure times.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
