Nighttime surveying reduces lanes on QEII south of Edmonton

Motorists are advised that the Queen Elizabeth II (QEII) Highway south of Edmonton will be reduced to one lane from 8 p.m. Sunday, March 13 to 5 a.m. Monday, March 14 between Ellerslie Road and Highway 19 for highway surveying. Traffic on the QEII Highway will also be reduced to one lane from 8 p.m. Monday, March 14 to 5 a.m. March 15. During the lane reductions, traffic will be reduced to 80 km/h. Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
