Highway 33 reduced to one lane over the Athabasca River south of Swan Hills

Fort Assiniboine... Motorists are advised that Highway 33 south of Swan Hill has been temporarily reduced to one lane following a collision over the Athabasca River near Fort Assiniboine. The alternating single lane of traffic and a lane width restriction of 3.7 metres will remain in effect until bridge repairs can be completed. Work is anticipated to be completed by April 9, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution in the area and obey all signs and flag people.
