## Paving reduces lanes on Highway 1 in Medicine Hat

**Medicine Hat...** Motorists can expect lane closures and speed limit reductions on Highway 1 within Medicine Hat.

Work begins April 25 on both the eastbound and westbound lanes of the highway within the city. The work involves rehabilitation of the road's concrete sections and paving the asphalt sections. Motorists can expect periodic lane closures and speed reductions through the construction zone.

The project will be completed by May 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
