High water closes a lane on QE2 near Lacombe

Lacombe... Motorists are advised that a lane closure on northbound Queen Elizabeth II Highway near Lacombe will be in effect until further notice.

The highway's right-hand, northbound lane is closed due to water accumulation and the speed limit has been reduced to 80 km/h through the closure zone. The affected area is approximately three kilometres south of Lacombe. The northbound left-hand lane is open while the southbound lanes are not affected.

The closure and speed reduction remains in effect until the water recedes from the roadway. Motorists are advised to use caution in the area or may wish to use alternate routes.

A further advisory will be issued when the lane reopens and the speed reduction is lifted.
