Paving closes lanes on Highway 1 near Chestermere

Chestermere... Motorists can expect lane closures and speed reductions on Highway 1 in the Chestermere area.

Paving is underway on both the westbound and eastbound lanes from Chestermere to the junction with Highways 9 and 797. Motorists can expect periodic lane closures and the speed limit will be reduced to 80 km/h through the construction zone. At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

Paving is scheduled for completion by May 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
