Anthony Henday Drive bridge opens on 170 Street in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that the new 170th Street bridge will open to traffic by approximately 7 p.m. on May 6, weather permitting.

The new bridge structure at 170th Street is part of the \$1.42 billion construction of the Northwest Anthony Henday Drive. This is the first of nine bridge structures to open to motorists this year along the northwest leg. The northwest Anthony Henday Drive project is on schedule and on budget to be completed by Nov. 1, 2011.

Though the 170th Street bridge will be open to traffic, construction activities will continue. Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
