Lessard Road and Anthony Henday Drive intersection closure in Edmonton

Edmonton... Motorists are advised that there will be a full access closure to and from Lessard Road at Anthony Henday Drive for four weeks from June 1 to July 1. Between July 1 to 15 access will be restored for motorists travelling to and from Lessard Road on the west side of Anthony Henday Drive, but will remain closed for motorists on the east side of Anthony Henday Drive. Motorists are advised to use Callingwood Road, 199 Street, and 184 Street as alternate access routes. Full access to Lessard Road will be restored when the new interchange opens to traffic July 15.

In addition, there will be a limited access closure from southbound Anthony Henday Drive to Callingwood Road and 62 Avenue for six weeks from Aug. 22 to Oct. 1. All other movements at the intersection will be maintained and open during construction. Construction of the new Callingwood Road interchange will be completed and open to traffic by Oct. 15.

Alberta Transportation is working closely with the City of Edmonton to coordinate adjacent city road construction work in order to minimize disruption for motorists.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs and message boards. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.

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
