Paving begins on Highway 13 between Killam and Hardisty

Killam... Motorists can expect speed reductions and delays on Highway 13 between Killam and Hardisty to accommodate paving.

Work begins May 18 to pave a 39-kilometre stretch between the two communities. During paving, traffic may be reduced to alternating single-lane and be directed by flag people. The speed limit may be reduced to 50 km/h through the construction zone.

Paving will be completed by June 30, weather permitting.

Motorists should use caution in the area and obey all signs, message boards, and flag people. Motorists are reminded that fines for speeding are doubled through construction zones when workers are present.
